

[Standard Document] EV424: The Global Integrity Protocol (SSOT v1.3) — Safe-Rail Addendum (EN)

Purpose: IR / Whitepaper / Global Partnership / Trust-Layer Standard

Scope: Integrity-only. The Non-Negotiable Boundary MUST remain unchanged across all official materials.

Non-Negotiable Boundary

EV424 DOES: Byte-level sameness (Same Bytes Same SHA-256) · Non-custodial (not stored/mirrored/hosted)

Open reproducibility (independent verification possible with the receipt alone).

EV424 DOES NOT: It does not judge truth/safety/legality · It does not analyze content or provide compliance

It does not take custody or host original files.

Revenue Safe-Rails

Consulting: Integrity Architecture Design (process, artifacts, and re-verification loops — not content judgment).

API & per-transaction: Receipt issuance infrastructure. Each call produces a verifiable sameness event; it never expires.

Ecosystem program: Conformance for process/format/independent verification. Use terms like EV424 Ready or EV424 Compliant.

Safe-Rail 2.0 (3 fixed statements)

A. Business

We do not review what the data says. We only prove it is still the same, and we offer that verification infrastructure.

B. Technical

EV424 does not judge. It only reproduces. We do not claim truth; we issue integrity receipts that any third party can verify.

C. Legal boundary

A PASS on an EV424 receipt is not an approval of legality. It is a mathematical confirmation of byte-level sameness.

Immutable Boundary Notice (must be attached to API/receipt)

This receipt attests byte-level sameness only. It does not judge truth, safety, or legality.

The source is referenced, not mirrored.

Final Attestation

EV424 does not judge truth or safety. It attests sameness with reproducible receipts.
